With my love for music I was soon playing music for Country Nights at dance clubs which expanded to campgrounds and weddings. We are fortunate to have trained with Skippy Blair and certify in her social dance

instructors program. We taught Two-Step, Line Dance, Waltz, Cha Cha, East & West Coast Swing, NC-2 and Couples Choreographed Dances at some of Connecticut's top night clubs thru the 90's.
